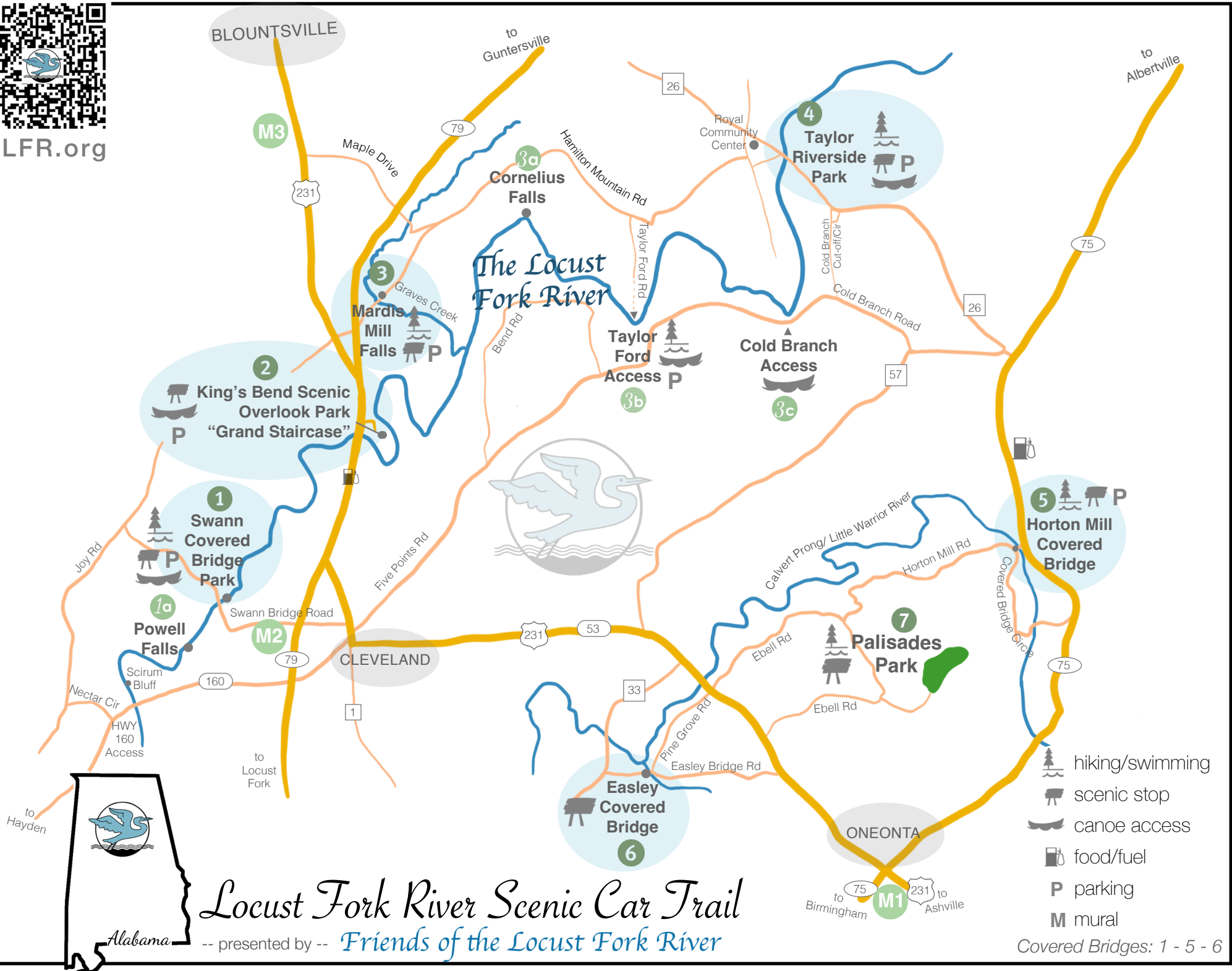


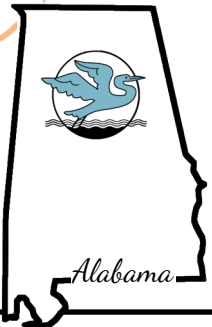

### SWANN COVERED BRIDGE PARK

scenic, exploring,  
wading, swimming,  
beach, hiking, canoe  
launch, camping

walking access from  
HWY 79, car access  
from Joy Rd (1590  
Swann Bridge Rd)

built in 1933

longest covered  
bridge in AL: 95 ft

spans the Locust Fork  
of the Black  
Warrior River

### SWANN BLUFF POWELL FALLS

8-10 ft twin falls

annual FLFR hike  
in October

30 minute hike  
downstream from  
Swann Covered  
Bridge, mildly difficult

### KING'S BEND SCENIC OVERLOOK PARK "Grand Staircase"

scenic, wading,  
short hike

take-out for  
Locust Fork Scenic  
River Trail

put-in for whitewater -  
CAUTION: training  
required!

### HORTON MILL COVERED BRIDGE

scenic, exploring

highest covered bridge  
in US: 70 ft

spans Calvert Prong of  
the Locust Fork of the  
Black Warrior River

creek appears to be  
flowing uphill

built 1934

### EASLEY COVERED BRIDGE

the first & oldest  
covered bridge

spans Dub Branch of  
the Calvert Prong of the  
Blackburn Branch of  
the Locust Fork River of  
the Black Warrior River

built in 1927

### MARDIS MILL FALLS

TOP 10 Waterfalls of N.  
Alabama

short - moderate  
difficulty

lovely .25 mi. hike  
downstream

Graves Creek of the  
Locust Fork of the  
Black Warrior River

### CORNELIUS FALLS

annual FLFR hike in May

swimming, camping,  
dramatic rock canyon

by canoe access, or an  
hour downstream hike,  
moderately difficult

120 ft wide, 5 ft tall
